The developer has already a wealth of industrial projects in its pipeline, including the maiden asset of its Industrial Development Fund, the E-Metro Logistics Park located in Bandar Bukit Raja in Klang, Selangor, which saw the commencement of its groundwork in July this year. Other ongoing industrial projects by the company include the Elmina Business Park in Sungai Buloh and the upcoming Serenia Business Park in Serenia City. Along the Southern Corridor, the property developer has XME Business Park which boasts the title as the first managed industrial park in Negeri Sembilan. Further down, an industrial park is developed as part of the Pagoh Special Economic Zone in Johor which offers special tax incentives as well as direct access to the North-South Expressway.

Through "We're the Go-To Experts", companies will have the opportunity to establish their businesses through its broad network of contacts, including but not limited to financial and supply chain players, along with innovative solutions and comprehensive built-to-suit and built-to-sell industrial plots to support a company's growth.

These factories, with sizes ranging from 50ft by 132.5ft to 85ft by 200ft in different layout types and loading options, was launched in December last year, and have since been fully taken up.

Sime Darby Property Industrial also offers custom-built facilities in Bandar Bukit Raja; Elmina Business Park; Hamilton Nilai City, Nilai; and Serenia City, Sepang.

In keeping with the ever-changing needs and requirements of its clients and stakeholders, and at the same time, remain cognisant of necessity to create impactful, long-lasting value, the company offers ample sustainable facilities in its
